### ***British Showjumping Rules and condition of entry***

- All classes are confined to registered horses and ponies ridden by members of British Showjumping in accordance with rule 79, except those purchasing a 'ticket to ride' on the day.
- In the event of substantial entries rule 268a (two phase) may be applied in certain classes.
- In the event of insufficient starters in any class, prize money may be withheld in accordance of rule 76.6
- The organisers shall not be liable for any claims in respect of damage or accident to any person, whether, competitor, servant or spectator.
- Competitors must wear correct riding clothes in accordance with British Showjumping Rules.
- It is mandatory for all members when mounted to wear a protective helmet to British Standard EN1384, ASTM 1163 or PAS 015.
- Lunging is not permitted on the showground.
- Any objections must be made to the organiser within 30 minutes of the completion of the event, accompanied by a deposit of £100 which by be forfeited if the objection is overruled.
- The judge's decision is final.
- The organisers reserve the right to cancel or amalgamate classes at their discretion.
- No dogs allowed on the centre.
- Please do not muck out your horsebox on to the car / lorry park. There will be a £50 fine if infringing this rule.
- Children under 16 must be supervised at all times.
- The organizer reserves the right to alter or amend rules at the discretion.
- All entries booked must be paid for. No refunds will be given unless the class is cancelled.
- All prize money must be collected on the day of the show, or it will be deemed to have been donated to the show
- A charge of £2 per rider will be made for a contribution towards First Aid.

Please note we only accept payment by credit /debit card or cash.

Cheques are NOT accepted as a form of payment.
